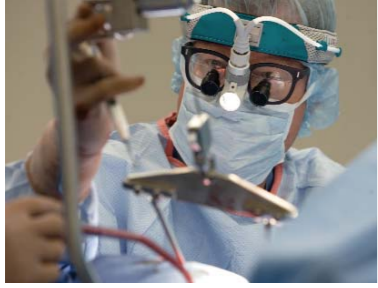

- The Frances Langford Heart Center opened August 2006 to treat heart disease—the number one killer in the United States. Martin Memorial partnered with the renowned Ocala Heart Institute (OHI) to bring world-class heart care to Stuart. Twenty-five million dollars needed for the heart center will be paid entirely by gifts from people just like you. Just think, for some, hope is a heartbeat away.

- Each year, philanthropy provides approximately 50 percent of the hospital’s “bottom line”—money that goes back into the health system to buy new medical technologies, improve facilities and invest in education for our skilled clinical staff.

What can you give?

Ways to give

- **Annual gifts** generate the equivalent income from a \$10 million endowment and each year the money is used where the need is greatest.
- **Recognition societies** acknowledge levels of giving. The Benefactors Society honors those who have made annual gifts of \$1,500. The Foundation provides Barstow Reed Society members—donors who contribute \$10,000 annually—special support for healthcare related matters.

- **Endowments** are a way you can invest in the future of health care while creating a lasting legacy today.
- **Gifts that pay you income** let you make a gift today, and receive income from that gift for a term of years or the rest of your life. These types of gifts usually require the help of your lawyer.
- **Bequests** let you control your assets during your lifetime. The Foundation can help you and your attorney prepare special provisions.
- **Commemorative gifts** give families and patients a way to thank a physician or a nurse, or to honor a friend or loved one.
- **Special events** like the Chrysanthemum Ball, the Novins Golf Tournament and the Goombay Bash generate money to support a variety of hospital-based programs.
